Executive Summary:

Humberside Police have been offered Home Office funding to transform its Audio, Visual and Multi-Media (AVMM) redaction capability by investing in the education and upskilling of staff across the force. The HO AVMM Fund have offered Humberside Police £120,000 to invest in a project. This project will address the current fragmented and manual redaction process, which causes delays, inefficiencies, and frustration for officers, staff, and victims. Focusing on training and awareness, the force aims to embed a consistent, legally compliant, and operationally effective approach to redaction at all levels.
