1. Executive Summary

During 2025-26, Section 27 funds totalling £152,608 were received. It is proposed the receipts are allocated on an equal basis to Humberside Police and the OPCC.

2. Recommendation

To provide formal approval of the allocation of £152,608 to be allocated: £76,304 to Humberside Police and £76,304 to the OPCC.

3. Background

During the 2025/26 financial year, funds totalling £152,608 were received, relating to drugs confiscation (Section 27).

Historically, these have been split equally between the OPCC and the Force, for each to use in addressing drugs related crime.

It is proposed that this allocation continue, with the below summary of the position.
