

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) – Request for Information. Our ref: FOI1326

I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request submitted to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside on 10 July 2026, as follows:

I would be grateful if you would provide answers to the following questions under the Freedom of Information Act. Do you commission a service to support women who have experienced sexual exploitation and/or who are involved in the sex industry? If yes: How much funding is provided? Is this funded via a particular funding stream? Is the funding specifically for support for those who have experienced sexual exploitation and/or who are involved in the sex industry, or is this part of a wider service (e.g. a sexual assault service that also supports those who have experienced sexual exploitation)?

In response to your request, I can advise that the following information is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside:

Commissioned Service	Service scope	Funding of contracted Service per annum £	Additional notes
The Blue Door ISVA Service. Humberside - Regional service	The scope of the ISVA service is to increase the emotional safety and wellbeing of all people in Humberside who experience sexual violence and abuse. The service supports all survivors to create a safe environment to help rebuild their lives.	460,000	This service is not gender exclusive. However, it does serve majority female clients, some of whom are current or previous sex workers. The service reports that they are actively supporting women who are sex working/exploited and attempt to meet the presenting (complex) needs. Often cutting across mental health and addiction.
